#### PERSONAL PROFILE

#### INTERNATIONAL SPORT EXPERIENCE

##### **Member of the Italian National Bobsleigh team, since 1982**

From 1985 to 1990 he competed in the Bobsleigh World Cup Tour as a 2 Man and 4 Man Bob Pilot and participated in the 1988 Winter Olympics in Calgary as a 2 Man Pilot. He was Vice European 2 Man Bob Junior Champion in 1986 in Igls Innsbruck, Austria and took 4th place in 4 Man Bob at the 1987 European Championship in Cervinia, Italy.

##### **Italian Bobsleigh Team Coach, from 1990 to 1994**

Participation at the Winter Olympics at Albertville 1992 and Lillehammer 1994.

##### **French Bobsleigh Head Coach, from 1994 to 1999**

France won the Bronze Medal in 4 Man Bob at the Winter Olympics at Nagano 1998

##### **Canadian Bobsleigh Head Coach, from 1999 to 2002**

Including the Winter Olympics at Salt Lake City 2002 when Canada took 5<sup>th</sup> place in 2 Man Bob.

##### **Italian Bobsleigh and Skeleton Team Director, from 2006 to 2010**

Created the Coach Certification for Bobsleigh and Skeleton for the Italian Winter Sport Federation (FISI).

##### **Torino 2006 TOROC Bob, Skeleton and Luge Competition Manger, from 2002 to 2006**

Responsible for the design, construction and sports operations of the track in Cesana Torinese. These responsibilities continued until 2010 as Track Manager at the Torino Post-Olympic Foundation.
