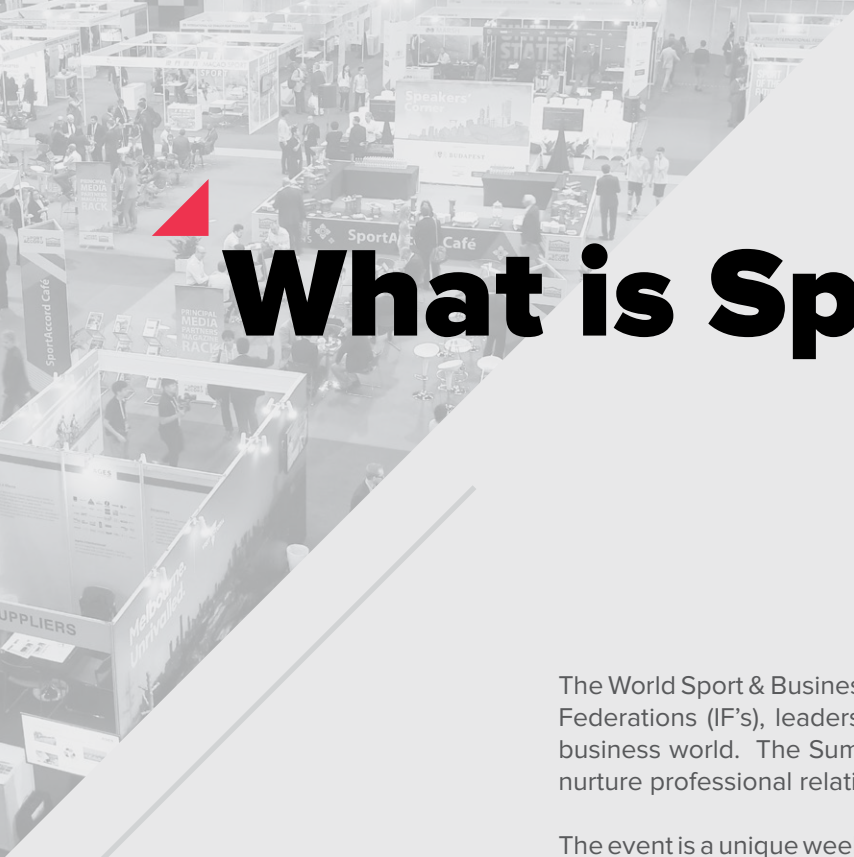

What is SportAccord?

The World Sport & Business Summit brings together key decision makers from over 100 International Federations (IF's), leaders from the International Olympic Committee and from across the sports business world. The Summit provides an unrivalled platform for attendees to share best practice, nurture professional relationships and identify opportunities for collaboration.

The event is a unique week-long combination of official meetings and social gatherings, a conference programme covering current themes and an exhibition space promoting services relevant to IF's and enabling cities and regions to showcase their sporting facilities.

Where has the SportAccord Summit been?

The cities and countries hosting the SportAccord Summit are as diverse as the fabric of sport itself. Since 2003, the summit has been hosted in 15 countries:





What are the hosting terms for the SportAccord Summit?

There is a management fee payable to SportAccord to cover the right to host the event and the supporting services provided by SportAccord.

The Local Organising Committee (LOC) is responsible for the majority of the operational budget:

Venue hire

Accommodation

Staffing

Branding and signage

Audiovisual and Information Technology

Exhibition build-up, booths, SportAccord café and networking zones

Transport and logistics

Opening ceremony, official dinner and closing ceremony

Catering

Typically, the LOC will be able to cover a substantial amount of these costs via local partnership deals as part of its overall commercial strategy.

What is the bidding and selection process?

Under the strategic direction of the SportAccord President and Executive Committee, the SportAccord Summit selection process is in four stages:
