


This would not have been achievable without the Ministry of Tourism and Sport and the Thai Government, the International Olympic Committee alongside GAISF

Whilst we protect the authority and autonomy of our member federations, we operate within the Olympic Movement and are one of the stakeholders of SportAccord.

We believe that the 2018 SportAccord edition, held in Bangkok, Thailand, was a great success which further strengthened the collaborative spirit within our family.

For ASOIF, it was an important platform to meet with all our members at the General Assembly and hold working meetings with the International Olympic Committee (IOC) as well as the Tokyo 2020 and Paris 2024 Olympic Games Organising Committees.

Another new project that we are excited about is the "Future of Global Sport and the Role of the IFs" which will examine and seek agreement on the status and responsibility of IFs in the sports landscape (2020-2040) between the interested stakeholders, particularly the public authorities at national and regional levels as well as business interests. The same study will also look at the speed of change impacting sport from geo-political, socioeconomic and technological influences.

We will continue to work closely together, in order to bring an important, positive impact on the future of sport and to tackle a number of challenges we are facing.



MANNUAL REVIEW



Our 2018 General Assembly marked further progress for GAISF on many fronts. In keeping with our Memorandum of Understanding, we are making good progress in servicing and supporting our members in many different areas.

This was highlighted at our General Assembly where Members voted to:

- Welcome the World
 Armwrestling federation (WAF)
 as a Full Member and the
 World Union of Olympic Cities
 and World Federation of the
 Sporting Goods Industry which
 become Associate Members.
- 2. Approve the International Jump Rope Union (IJRU) as the 10th International Federation to gain GAISF Observer status.
- 3. Change our Statutes to emphasise our commitment to equality and the promotion of women's rights and opportunities in sport by adding new text: 'GAISF encourages and supports the promotion of women in sport at all levels and in all structures with a view to implementing the principle of equality of men and women.'

Updates were provided to members on developments in key areas:

MULTI-SPORT GAMES

GAISF President Patrick Baumann and ANOC President Sheik Ahmed Al-Sabah in the presence of International Olympic Committee President Thomas Bach signed an agreement covering the organisation of editions of the World Beach Games after 2019. The World Beach Games will be held every two years following the edition being organised by ANOC in San Diego in 2019. The

Sport Program will be determined in agreement with the IOC and in principle no Olympic events will be included in future Beach Games.

WORLD URBAN GAMES

The process was launched to select a host city for the inaugural World Urban Games in either 2019 or 2020. The concept, to stage a five-day celebration of new-generation sports received a warm and enthusiastic welcome from both potential hosts and International Federations during

special briefing presentations during SportAccord.

DOT.SPORT INITIATIVE

GAISF's Dot.Sport initiative will be rolled-out in the coming months giving members the opportunity to acquire the valuable asset of their unique digital signature through internet address extensions relevant to their sports and individual disciplines in a range of languages.

WORLD SPORTS INDEX

GAISF is currently working with sports data and media company Nielsen Sport and InfoStrada to develop a World Sports Index which will, effectively, create the first global performance tables compiled based on results from across all events of all sports. This will provide comparison information creating an important strategic planning tool and investment guide for IFs and their national members as well as for NOCs.

GAISF MEMBERSHIP PLATFORM

Work is progressing on the development of a digital Membership Platform. The Platform gives open access for members, allowing them to store and update their information as necessary as they make their journey through the IOC pyramid.

HOSTING WINNERS

Sport Event Denmark is celebrating 10 Years! With numerous World Championships and European Championships in Denmark, we are proud to welcome the World of Sport. In the coming years Denmark will host many more world-class events.

Starting in 2018 including: Sailing World Championships for all Olympic classes, ITU Multisport World Championships Festival and IIHF Ice Hockey World Championship.

MANNUAL REVIEW



Since its foundation in 1983, ASOIF's role has been to serve and represent the Summer Olympic IFs in the most competent, articulate and professional manner on issues of common interest in the Summer Olympic Games and the Olympic Movement.

The 2018 SportAccord saw our members convene at our annual General Assembly, where we held important discussions on the results of the Second ASOIF Governance Review, which assessed all ASOIF member federations, including the five new associate members. The project has been driven by ASOIF's Governance Taskforce, aimed at helping IFs to promote and ensure good governance within their structures and operations. The objectives of this second review were

to provide continued impetus for IFs to reach or maintain a high standard of governance; track governance improvements since the initial review

last year; and identify best practices. The full report is available on our website.

The General Assembly also learnt more details about ASOIF's new

project on the "Future of Global Sport and the Role of the IFs". The objective is to enable IFs to have a better understanding of what the future may look like when taking important decisions often with long-term implications.

A report will be published in September this year. In addition, ASOIF will set up a new Sports Innovation Taskforce, which will follow up on the report and look specifically into the topics of fan engagement, new technologies and big data.

ASOIF member federations elected Nenad Lalovic, UWW President, as an ASOIF Council member for a three-year term of office. In February, the IOC Session had elected Lalovic as the ASOIF representative to the IOC Executive Board.



During this excellent edition of SportAccord 2018 in Bangkok, the focal event for the Winter IFs was the AIOWF Annual General Assembly. The previous time AIOWF met officially was two months earlier at the PyeongChang 2018 Olympic Winter Games, where it was 60 degrees colder than in Thailand!

The main topic on the Winter Federation's agenda was analysing PyeongChang 2018, notably in preparation for the IOC-IF Review preceeding the Official IOC Debrief in Beijing taking place early June. The Winter IFs would like to take this opportunity to once again express our thanks and compliments to the Organising Committee and all Partners and Stakeholders on the great success of the Olympic Winter Games 2018 in PyeongChang, Korea.

Other key topics addressed by the

Winter Federations at the General Assembly involved discussions with WADA, addressing the plans for the International Testing Agency and the Court of Arbitration for Sport installation of a permanent specialist Anti-Doping Division.

Elections of the AIOWF representatives for the next fouryear cycle took place at the General Assembly in Bangkok. The members re-elected Gian Franco Kasper as President, together with the Presidents of the other six Winter Sports forming the AlOWF Council. Sarah Lewis of FIS is appointed as AlOWF Secretary General. Additionally Ivo Ferriani, President of Bobsleigh IBSF was nominated for election as the AlOWF representative on the IOC Executive Board.

The AIOWF Member IFs would like to wish all ASOIF, ARISF and AIMS Colleagues from the Summer Sports great competition seasons and a very successful edition of the Youth Olympic Games in Buenos Aires in October.

Finally may we commend GAISF, through President Patrick Baumann, on its progress and the services provided for the International Federations, and to SportAccord and the hosts in Bangkok, including GAISF Council Member and colleague Stephan Fox, on this really successful edition of SportAccord.
