



# Sport Accord 2024 VISA & ETA Application User Guide

The purpose of this guidance is to provide delegates of Sport Accord 2024 the relevant information and links to enable them to apply for either a VISA or ETA to attend the conference.

## Do I need a Visa to enter the United Kingdom?

Delegates from the following list of countries require a Visa to enter the UK (information correct as of 15<sup>th</sup> December 2023):

## The UK Visa Application Process

All Visa applications must be submitted online using the link below. Before applying for your Visa, please have your passport and method of payment ready.

Once you have completed the application form is completed, you will be taken automatically to the visa payment site where you will enter your payment details and pay for your visa application. Once payment has been taken you will be automatically re-directed to the booking page for the Visa Application Centre (VAC) in your country of origin. An appointment will be available for you to book within 5 days of your visa application being made. You will need to visit a Visa Application Centre for your fingerprint and electronic photograph to be captured. **It is not until you have visited the Visa Application Centre that the 15 day processing time for your visa begins.**

## UK Visa application Timings & Cost

It will take 15 days from the date you visit the Visa Application Centre for your visa to be processed and issued. Please ensure that you allow sufficient time to apply for your visa to attend Sport Accord 2024. The standard cost of a UK Visa is **£115**. In the event of you are not able to meet this timescale there are options for a quicker service. This will significantly increase the cost of your visa.

The table below shows the timings and cost for a UK visa and the dates below are based on a travel date into the UK of 6<sup>th</sup> April 2024 and show the latest possible date Visa applications can be made.

Priority Service (PV)	<b>01/04/2024</b>	<b>£500</b>	5 working days	Limited application centres
Super Priority Service (SPV)	<b>05/04/2024</b>	<b>£1000</b>	Next working day	Limited application centres
