Introduction

The World Urban Games is the ultimate celebration of new-generation sports forged by the spirit of youth. It is a showcase for the skill, style and power of the most inspirational urban athletes on the planet.

Powered by the Global Association of International Sports Federations (GAISF), the World Urban Games will, for five days, be the beating heart for sports whose massive youth appeal has created a galaxy of stars and an army of passionate fans.

The World Urban Games concept delivers a spectacular yet compact and manageable event which offers cities a unique opportunity for focused international promotion, to engage with their youth communities in new and exciting ways and to promote public health and wellness agendas through inspiring initiatives encouraging participation in urban sports.

Through extensive global media coverage, it also creates a remarkable showcase for the city, aligning it in the eyes of the world with the youthful energy and incredible talent of the competitors and with the cultural creativity and passion for arts and music highlighted in the Festival.

The following sports and disciplines are eligible to be included in the World Urban Games Competition programme. GAISF in collaboration with the Host will establish the final Sports Programme at the end of the Award Process.

Showcase events

The following sports and disciplines are eligible to be included in the World Urban Games Showcase programme. GAISF in collaboration with the Host will establish the final Sports Programme at the end of the Award Process.

- Baseball & Softball: Baseball5
- Rowing: Indoor Rowing
- Flying Disc: Freestyle
- Modern Pentathlon: Laser run

The aim of such a programme is to promote sports/disciplines which are innovative and appealing to the youth and local population but have not yet reached the required level of maturation to be part of the Competition programme. In collaboration with GAISF, the respective IFs and the NFs, the LOC shall develop a concept to display the Showcase events in a fun and engaging way.
